

What is Alcoholics Anonymous?

Alcoholics Anonymous is a book first published in 1939 that provides clear-cut and precise instructions on how to recover from alcoholism. The Alcoholics Anonymous program of recovery contained in this book has helped millions of men and women to recover from a seemingly helpless and hopeless state of mind and body.

Recovery takes place as soon as the alcoholic begins following the directions in the book -- a process that leads alcoholics through AA's 12 Steps and to a life free from alcohol. It helps them to discover a Power that can and will do for them what they have been powerless and unable to do for themselves -- and to sustain them while

helping other alcoholics to recover (which is also necessary for continuing recovery).

Alcoholics Anonymous is also a fellowship of men and women who share their experience, strength and hope with each other that they may solve their common problem and help others to recover from alcoholism.

The only requirement for membership in the Alcoholics Anonymous Fellowship is a desire to stop drinking. There are no dues or fees for AA membership. We are self-supporting through our own contributions.

AA is not allied with any sect, denomination, politics, organization or institution. Does not wish to engage in any controversy, neither endorses nor opposes any causes. Our primary purpose is to stay sober and help other alcoholics to achieve sobriety.
